Job Description

The Utah Suicide Prevention Coalition is hiring a Live On Ambassador that will promote Live On messages, and the free course on [@liveonutah's](#) Instagram on their campus, to increase mental health and suicide prevention awareness and skills in their peers.

The Ambassador may:

- Be certified to provide suicide prevention training to their peers and campus staff
- Engage in activities that build protective factors in their peers
- Table events to share Live On materials and talk to peers about mental health and suicide prevention

The Live On Ambassador will:

- Receive a stipend upon satisfactorily completing their hours, of up to \$2,000. The exact amount will depend on the number of hours worked.
- Be trained, mentored by, and report to, an employee of the Utah Office of Substance Use and Mental Health and NAMI Utah's Prevention Director.
- Gather data to demonstrate the reach and impact of their efforts, such as number of presentations and estimated number of attendees at each event.

To receive the full stipend of \$2,000, the Live On Ambassador must log about two hours per week and at least 110 work hours during the 6 month term, and submit evaluation data. If less than 110 work hours are logged, the Live On Ambassador will be paid \$18 per hour for all hours logged of approved activities.
